We have received this letter from the FISH food bank: “FISH needs your help to make sure Ellensburg’s hungry children are fed through the summer. School will soon be out and that will leave many of our children without access to food for lunch. School food programs provide our hungry children a nutritious breakfast and lunch and when the school year ends, so do the meals.

“For the past eight years, FISH has distributed lunch to our children all summer and we need your help to continue to pay for this vital program.

“Please help FISH feed the community’s hungry children this summer.

“Each day during the summer, FISH will prepare nutritious lunches and deliver them to parks throughout our community. Our volunteers will distribute the free lunches to our hungry children. It may be the most balanced meal that child receives that day.

“Why do these kids need a free lunch? The limited family income of our working poor is spent on rent and utilities and gas – there’s often not much left to buy food. So every night, and every morning, helpless Kittitas County children go hungry. FISH’s “Picnic in the Park” summer meal program provides a wholesome and healthy free lunch for our children.
